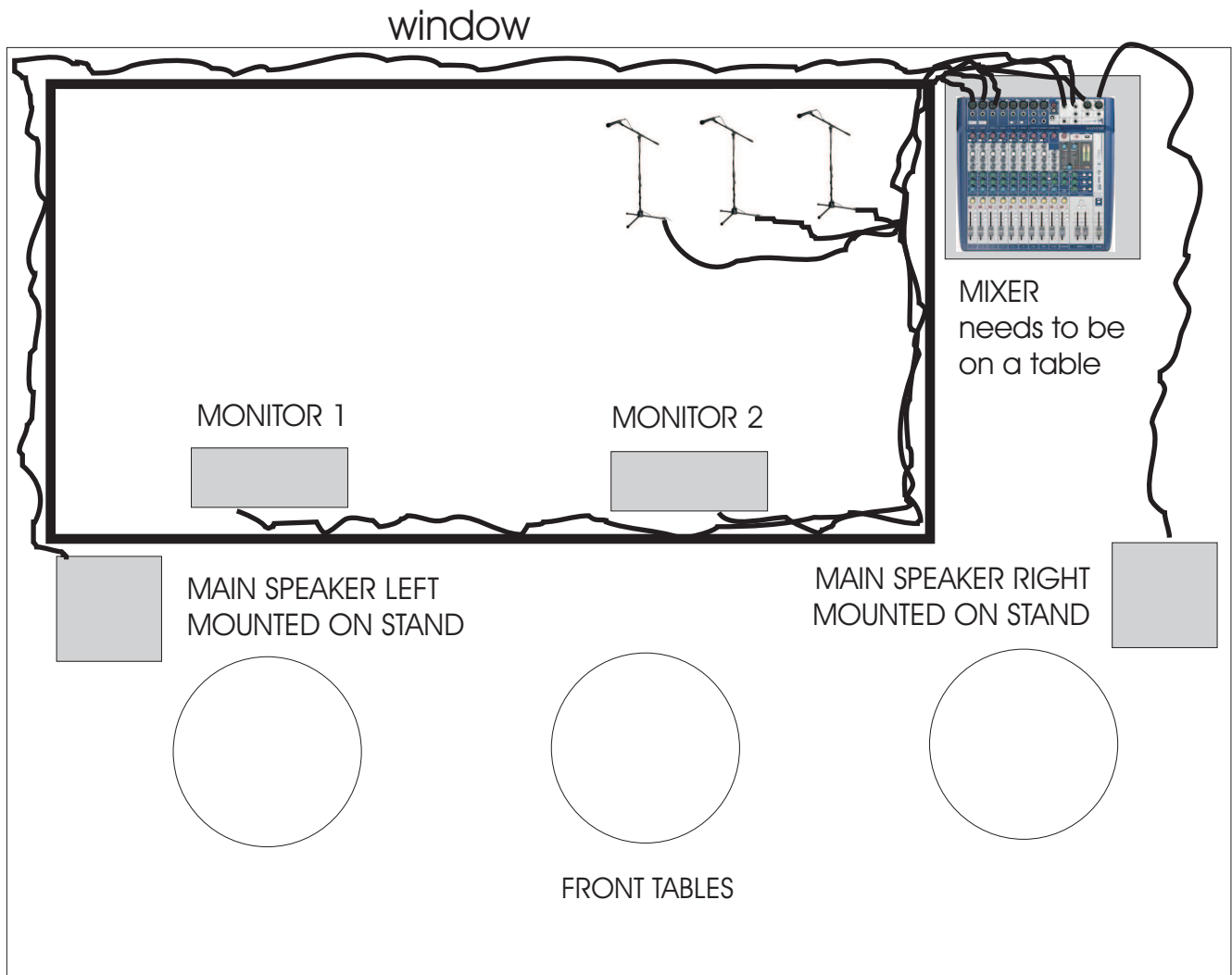


AFTER DARK SOUND SYSTEM SETUP



SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- All units will need power, so you may need extension cords to get AC power to each of them.
- Be careful to not leave cables too exposed. Musicians can easily trip on such things. Run them behind the stage or along the wall when possible.
- Please setup 3 mics on stage, close to the mixer and number them (just write 1,2,3 on some masking tape and tape to base)
- Number the mics corresponding channels on the soundboard (this way musicians can easily determine which mic is connected to which channel wasting time tracing cables back to the mixer).
- Please test all 3 mics to make sure they can be heard in both mains and monitors. Leave the levels where they are when done (ie - don't zero them)
- When finished, please turn everything off -- and leave a note on the mixer stating "the mixer, mains and monitors all need to be turned on to get sound" (some musicians are not sound tech saavy so need to be told this).
- Store any extra mics, mic stands and cables somewhere safe. Eventually a bandleader will ask to use them, and you want to make sure you know exactly where they are when that happens.
